

REGULATIONS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA

1.0001 General Description and Address of Agency.

(1) The University of Florida is a land-grant, sea-grant, and space-grant research institution awarding bachelor's degrees, master's degrees, specialist's degrees, degrees on the doctorate level, and professional degrees. Its mission is to offer broad-based, inclusive public education, leading edge research, and service to the citizens of Florida, the nation and the world.

(2) The University of Florida Board of Trustees, a public body corporate and instrumentality of the State of Florida, is the University's legal entity and sets policy and provides governance for the University pursuant to its powers as established by the Florida Board of Governors and applicable law. The Board of Governors is a body created under the Florida Constitution that is responsible for the management of the State University System of Florida.
